The least of these

... God chose the weak of the world to shame the strong... *1 Corinthians 1:27*

The world's priorities are completely upside down from what disciples of Jesus value. It's as true today as when our Lord gave his famous Sermon on the Mount. When my faith runs counter to the values of my party, family, tribe or culture, how do I put God first?

What is radical worldview that offends the powers that be? It runs through all of Scripture: God stands on the side of losers everywhere.

Jesus pronounces God's blessing and favor on a special group, who in the Old Testament were known by a Hebrew term laden with meaning and often written in English as the "anawim." They were the poor, the meek, the downtrodden and forsaken. The anawim are not just those on the margins of society but those overwhelmed by need who can only turn to God. Second, in imitating Jesus, may our greatest concern go to those in most need.

Las prioridades del mundo están completamente al revés de lo que valoran los discípulos de Jesús. Es tan cierto hoy como cuando nuestro Señor pronunció su famoso Sermón de la Montaña. Cuando mi fe va en contra de los valores de mi partido, familia, tribu o cultura, ¿cómo pongo a Dios primero?

¿Cuál es la cosmovisión radical que ofende a los poderes fácticos? Recorre toda la Escritura: Dios está del lado de los perdedores en todas partes.

Jesús pronuncia la bendición y el favor de Dios sobre un grupo especial, que en el Antiguo Testamento eran conocidos por un término hebreo cargado de significado y a menudo escrito en inglés como "anawim". Eran los pobres, los mansos, los oprimidos y los desamparados. Los anawim no son solo aquellos que están al margen de la sociedad, sino también aquellos abrumados por la necesidad que solo pueden volverse hacia Dios. En segundo lugar, al imitar a Jesús, que nuestra mayor preocupación vaya hacia los más necesitados

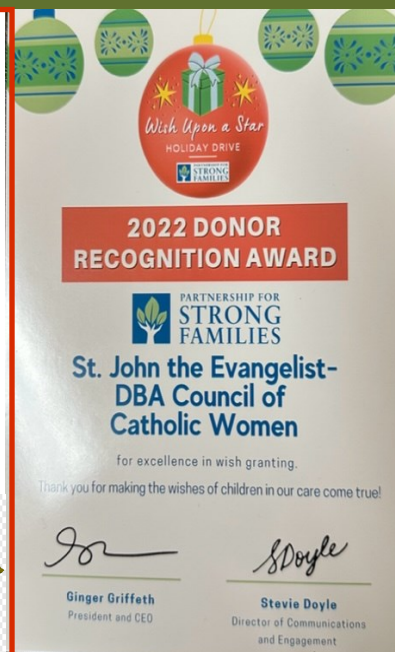
